

Priority entrance into Children's Festival events will be given to:

Children (over 6 years) who have child (6 –11) week tickets and children 5 years and under whose parent/carer has purchased the appropriate adult ticket.

Children aged 6 and above without a week ticket may pay on the door if space is available.

For children 5 years and under whose parents/carers do not have appropriate adult tickets, admission charges will apply by paying on the door.
